G2iX, his latest venture, unifies the portfolio to deliver a complete innovation platform.

Winston's past entrepreneurial endeavors included Gluecode Software, an open source application infrastructure company that Winston grew to profitability before securing Series A funding and subsequently sold to IBM in 2005, Logicblaze, acquired by Iona Technologies, and DevZuz (formerly Simula Labs), which was bought by Exist in 2007.

Prior to his entrepreneurial endeavors, Winston was among the highest performing venture capital professionals at Intel, having led the majority of his investments to either a successful IPO or a profitable corporate acquisition. He served under various leadership roles -- managing strategic software relationships, channel development, product engineering, and new business development.

Winston currently serves his second term as International Marketing Director for the Philippine Software Industry Association, a non-profit organization that aims to promote the growth and global competitiveness of the Philippine software industry.
